**Call for Nomination: BSA Award 2010**

Nominations are invited for BSA Award 2010.

BSA Award is a prestigious recognition and honor bestowed for excellence in agronomic education, research and scientific services. The award is granted to outstanding individuals or groups whose distinguished contribution over a period of time to the advancement of agronomic science is clearly recognized through leadership excellence and/or excellence in research and/or education.

Nomination may be submitted by a member of the Bangladesh Society of Agronomy. Only active members of the Bangladesh Society of Agronomy may nominate. The award will be presented to the recipients at the 9th Biennial Conference of Bangladesh Society of Agronomy to be held on 6-7, October 2010 at Dhaka.

A current CV of the nominee should accompany the letter of nomination. In addition, the nominator should include materials that illustrate the contributions of the nominee. Supporting letters, not ordinarily required, but may be included as part of the nomination packet.

The letter of nomination should address the following points:

1. The general nature of the nominee's contributions to the advance of agronomic science. Professional contribution/service within and beyond the organization(s) where the nominee has been serving,
2. Involvement in the professional organizations and positions held,
3. Professional recognition (beyond the organization of the nominee),
4. List of publications,
5. Nominee's resume.
6. The nominator must provide his or her full name, and contact details including email, professional and organizational affiliation.
