Major Decisions and Guidelines for Presentations

The organizing committee held a meeting on 19 September 2010 at SAARC Agriculture center and decided the followings:

- There will be speakers from IRRI, India etc. in the technical sessions. Therefore, organizing committee has declared the conference as “**9th Biennial International Conference**”
- BSA will not publish any workshop proceedings. Instead, a special issue of the **Bangladesh Agronomy Journal** will be published with the presented papers of the conference. All the papers will be reviewed by a panel of reviewers.
- Papers if presented in the conference will be considered for publication in the journal and those will not make presentation will not be considered.
- Full papers must be submitted electronically by 15 October 2010, complete review by 25 November 2010 and publish the special issue of **Bangladesh Agronomy Journal** by 31 December 2010.
- There will be 1 Inaugural session and 5 technical sessions followed by Business session.
- Maximum number of speakers will be given chance to present their papers and share research results in the conference.
- Considering the problems of logistics there will be no poster session.
- Of the received 65 abstracts, up to 40 papers will be considered for oral presentations.
- There will be maximum 10 minutes per paper of which 7 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for discussion.
- Only Power Point Presentations through multimedia will be allowed.
- All 65 papers are eligible for presentations. Based on previous experiences, it has been noted that all submitted papers are not generally presented and some author (s) do not like to present their paper.

- Maximum 40 papers will be allowed to make oral presentations and that will be finally selected by the organizing committee.
- To make a specific program of the workshop for technical sessions, it is now very important and urgent to ascertain who is finally interested to make oral presentation of his/her papers.
- All those who have submitted abstracts (65) are requested kindly to inform us in the reply mail expressing your **final interest to present paper.**
- Please write your abstract number and name of the speaker in the subject line of your e-mail.
- **The dead line to send your interest for oral presentation of papers is 25 September 2010.**
- If we do not receive any reply/information about any paper for presentation we shall not consider that paper for presentation and will not be included in the workshop program.
