#### **Nominations are invited for BSA Award 2012**

BSA award is a prestigious recognition and honour bestowed for excellence in agronomic education, research and scientific services. The award is granted to outstanding individuals or groups whose distinguished contribution over a period of time to the advancement of agronomic science is clearly recognized through leadership excellence and/ or excellence in research and/ or education.

Nomination may be submitted by a member of the Bangladesh Society of Agronomy. Only active/deceased members of the Bangladesh Society of Agronomy may be nominated for the award. The award will be presented to the recipients at the 11 th Conference of Bangladesh Society of Agronomy to be held on 6, October 2012.

The letter of nomination should address the following points:

1. Nominees resume
2. The general nature of the nominee's contribution to the advancement of agronomic science and education. Professional contribution/ service within and beyond the organization(s) where the nominee has been serving.
3. Involvement in the professional organizations and positions held with experiences
4. Professional recognition (beyond the organization of the nominee)
5. List of publications
6. The nominator must provide his or her full name and contact details including email, professional and organization affiliation

**Guidelines for Award Committee:**

1. BSA develops and circulates guidelines and procedure for submission and evaluation of nomination.
2. Nomination letter following guidelines and procedure are to be forwarded to the award committee
3. Submission of comprehensive portfolio of the nominee describing the contribution of the nominee
4. Committee may use formatted score sheet for evaluating the nominations
5. Scores of individual members would be compiled and recommendations for selection made on merit
6. The Award Committee may either endorse or reject, partially or fully, the recommendations of the Awards Committee.
